1 Study work	At the department, training was carried out in the bachelor's and specialist's OOP of full-time and dual forms of education and in the master's OOP.
2 Educational and methodical work	In order to provide educational and methodological support for the disciplines, the formation of educational and methodological complexes of disciplines was carried out, during which an analysis of the staffing of the UMKD was constantly carried out at the meetings of the departments of the 1st semester (ave. No. 10 of 05/21/2023), the 2nd semester (ave. No. 4 of 11/24/2023). Banks of test tasks have been formed for all disciplines of the OP (approved by the head of the department, protocol No. 1 of 08/26/2023), registered in the department of monitoring the quality of the educational process.
3 Scientific work	Research work at the Department of Zootechnology and Veterinary Medicine for the 2023-2024 academic year, along with the educational process, was carried out in full and is one of the important components of the activities of the faculty and students of the department. In the 2023-2024 academic year, the senior lecturer of the department, Sharapatov Tlekbol Sungatovich, successfully defended his dissertation and received a PhD degree in OP 8D08201 – Animal Science. In the 2023-2024 academic year, associate professors of the department Usenova L.M., Abeldinov R.B., Asanbaev T.S., Seiteuov T.K. By order of the Chairman of the Committee for Quality Assurance in Science and Higher Education of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan were awarded the academic titles of associate professors (associate professors) in the scientific field 40300 – Veterinary and 40200 – Animal Husbandry and animal husbandry. And professors of the department Burambayeva N.B. and Temirzhanova A.A. were awarded academic titles of professor in the scientific field of Animal Husbandry and animal husbandry.
