1. The post-accreditation monitoring stage was successfully completed for three educational programs: 6B02101 – Instrumental Performance, 6B02103 – Vocal Arts, and 6B02104 – Acting;

2. The work on the grant-funded research project “The Artistic and Aesthetic Environment of Pavlodar Region in the Second Half of the 20th Century” (2023–2025, Project Leader – M. P. Popandopulo) has been completed. As part of the research project, office and computer equipment was purchased, including 4 all-in-one computers, 2 laptops, 2 netbooks, and 2 interactive panels;

3. The academic staff of the Department have publications in journals indexed in the Scopus database, publications in journals included in the list of journals recommended by the Committee for Quality Assurance in Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan, publications in the proceedings of international conferences, as well as articles in foreign academic journals;

4. The textbook “Elementary Music Theory” (“Бастауыш теория музыкасы”) was published (D. R. Mukatova, S. A. Temirbekova);

5. The textbook “Modern Vocal Technologies Using Artificial Intelligence” was published (M. A. Valieva);

6. 65 students of the Department completed courses on the international educational platform Coursera and received international certificates;

7. Academic staff and students of the Department completed courses in artificial intelligence;

8. Professor E. Kh. Aitbayev was awarded the Order of “Parasat” and received the title of Chevalier of the Order;

9. Second- and third-year students Aydyn Beisen and Zhalyn Kunanbay, enrolled in the 6B02103 – Vocal Arts educational program, were awarded the titles of Laureates of the 2nd and 3rd Degrees, respectively, at the Republican Traditional Singing Competition held in Turkistan;

10. Third-year student Daniyar Akhmetbek, enrolled in the 6B02104 – Acting educational program, was awarded the title of Laureate of the 3rd Degree at the Republican Olympiad in Acting Skills held in Astana;

11. The academic staff and students of the Department actively participate in intra-university, regional, and national cultural events. Educational and extracurricular activities are carried out in accordance with the plans of the Faculty, the Department, and academic advisors for educational work and social issues.
